Obtaining this certificate gives access to the first year of studies at the UFR Law, Economics and Social Sciences. The certificate allows the student to enroll directly without going through the request procedure (DAP).

Faculty of Law, Economics and Social Sciences

Linked directly by the tramway to the city center and to the train station in 15 minutes, situated on the campus Deux Lions, in a country setting, the Faculty welcomes 4500 students each year. These students find an agreeable environment focused on their university studies: library, computer lab, language resource center, lodging and a university cafeteria but also a shopping center, cinemas, a park and a lake.

Licence in Law:

Aiming to acquire a general law culture, this degree includes the essentials necessary to understand and use the tools of law, through a theoretical and practical teaching of Public and Private Law, as well as through learning juridical methodology.

Licence in Economics:

Allows students to develop their analytical capacities in economics, learning the principles of macroeconomics and microeconomics but also econometrics, statistics, computer science and modeling.

Licence Social and Economic Administration: (AES)

A general degree. Pluri-disciplinary studies allow the student to master law, economic and management data. Included in the program are studies of: Political Science, Statistics, History and Sociology.

These three licences can be earned in 3 years (normally 6 semesters). The first year offers special pedagogical assistance (an orientation week, tutorials, classes with a limited enrollment).
